RESOLUTION NO. 103-2024

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 02 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023 OF MANAOAG, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P10,090,000.00, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Manaoag, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 02 for CY 2023 involving total appropriations of P10,090,000.00, which was enacted on November 21, 2023 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2, S-2023;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

- That the funding sources for the subject Supplemental Budget were determined in accordance with Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160 and Article 417(a) of its IRR, as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993;
- 2. That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;

- That all programs, projects and activities to be implemented are in accordance with the approved CY 2023 Annual Investment Program of the municipality and its supplements thereto formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated 08 March 2007;
- 4. That the appropriations for Public Affairs Fund shall solely for public purposes and no amount shall be applied for religious or private purposes pursuant to Section 305 (b) and 335 of R.A No. 7160, and shall be broken down into appropriate objects of expenditures, as may be applicable, in accordance with the Revised Chart of Accounts for LGUs under COA Circular 2015-009 dated December 1, 2015; and
- 5. That the disbursement of appropriation for Terminal Leave Benefits shall be subject to the provisions of DBM Budget Circular No. 2016-2 dated March 29, 2016 re: Computation & Funding of Terminal Leave Benefits and Monetization of Leave Credits, which provides for the new constant factor stated under Item 3.1 thereof.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the Municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Marinor B. De Guzman and Jerry Agerico B. Rosario and co-sponsored by SP Members Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., Joyce D. Fernandez and Maria Doriza V. Ramos, duly seconded, it was-

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in its Entirety the Supplemental Budget No. 02 for Calendar Year 2023 of Manaoag, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Manaoag, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
