PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 156-2024

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO MAKE A DEFINITIVE UNIFICATION OF THE CADASTRAL SURVEY AND THE POLITICAL OR JURISDICTIONAL SURVEY TO IDENTIFY A COMMON CADASTRAL, POLITICAL AND JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES OF ALL LGUS IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, under Section 4 of Executive Order No. 192, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) is mandated to be the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, development and proper use of the country's environment and natural resources, including those in reservations, watershed areas and lands of the public domain, as well as the licensing and regulation of all natural resources utilization as may be provided by law in order to ensure equitable sharing of the benefits derived therefrom for the welfare of the present and future generations of Filipinos;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Order No. 45-1993, the Philippines Reference System of 1992 was created as the Standard Reference System for all surveying and mapping activities in the Philippines where it mandates that all new surveys and maps as well as old surveys shall be integrated in the Philippine Reference System of 1992;

WHEREAS, Section 5, DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2007-29 defines Cadastral Survey as a survey made to determine the metes and bounds of all parcels within an entire municipality or city for land registration and other purposes;

WHEREAS, Chapter II, Art II, Section 53 (b) of Manual on Land Survey Procedures provides that a Political Boundary Survey refers to the establishment of political boundary monuments defining the boundary lines of the entire city/municipality and their components;

WHEREAS, it was discovered during a recent question hour in Plenary Session of the Sanggunian Panlalawigan and the Joint Committee Hearing of the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and Energy and Committee on Laws and Ordinances regarding quarry operations particularly in the Municipality of Sison, that there are conflicting references of jurisdiction, political boundaries and cadastral surveys in the province of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, there is a need to update and establish accurate survey and mapping of cadastral surveys and the political or jurisdictional surveys of the different LGUs in the Province of Pangasinan in consonance with Philippine Reference System of 1992;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member Nicholi Jan Louie Sison, duly seconded, it was-


RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled to request, as it is hereby requested, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources to make a definitive unification of the cadastral survey and the political or jurisdictional survey to identify a common cadastral, political and jurisdictional boundaries of the LGUs in the province of Pangasinan;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Honorable Governor, Ramon V. Guico III, Atty. Crizaldy M. Barcelo, DENR Regional Director, San Fernando City, La Union, and Atty. Geronimo Abad, Provincial Assessor, for their information and appropriate action.
