RESOLUTION NO. 190-2024

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 133-2023 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 2 CY 2023 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of San Jacinto, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 133-2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

- 1. The Municipal Development Council of San Jacinto, Pangasinan prepared the municipality's Supplemental Investment Program No. 2 for CY 2023. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 2023-02 dated September 20, 2023, to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This is in accordance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;
- 2. Said Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which has a total investment requirement of ₱34,492,121.25, covers the augmentation of funds for Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), and Capital Outlays of some departments of the LGU, and the implementation of development projects and other priority projects supportive to tobacco farmers of the municipality;





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- 3. The projects proposed to be funded from the 20% Development Fund and Tobacco Excise Tax are based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects), and Local Budget Memorandum No. 86 dated December 14, 2022 (Guidelines on the Release and Utilization of the Shares of LGUs from Tobacco Excise Tax) of the Department of Budget and Management, respectively; and
- 4. Funding for the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 1, CY 2023, which was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2023-01, Series of 2023, dated October 27, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of San Jacinto, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Marinor B. De Guzman and Jerry Agerico B. Rosario and co-sponsored by SP Members Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was-

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 133-2023 of the Sangguniang Bayan of San Jacinto, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the Supplemental Investment Program No. 2 CY 2023 of the Municipality of San Jacinto, Pangasinan";
