PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 284-2022

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT ROUTE PLAN (LPTRP) OF THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, Section 16 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of full employment among their residents and preservation of the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 468 of the same Code also provides that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, as the legislative body of the province, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the province and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the same Code mandates national government agencies to coordinate, inform and involve local government units (LGUs) in the planning and implementation of their respective programs, projects and activities;

WHEREAS, Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, dated June 19, 2017, of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) provides the need for local government units to craft a Local Public Transport Route Plan designating and enforcing public transport routes based on the LGUs development plans and its mastery of its own mobility and accessibility needs;

WHEREAS, Pangasinan, a premier province in Region I, has envisioned a well-managed transport sector where drivers and operators can have an organized transport system to be able to bring the commuters to their destinations swiftly, safely and securely, along side with having a steady source of livelihood;

WHEREAS, to ensure the smooth transition to the current administration the functions of the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) Team, Executive Order No. 0178-2022, was issued by the Provincial Governor, Ramon V. Guico III, reconstituted the said team for the formulation, preparation, updating and submission of the LPTRP of the Province of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2022, the said LPTRP was submitted to the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) and the DOTr by the LPTRP Committee, and was found to be consistent with the DOTr's Department Order No. 2017-011 or the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of the Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance, otherwise known as the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG), and all other pertinent LTFRB Memorandum Circulars; and consequently, a Notice of Compliance was granted to the Province on October 26, 2022 and with instruction to enact an ordinance adopting the said LPTRP;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Vici M. Ventanilla and co-authored by all Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, duly seconded,

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan that:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as an Ordinance Adopting the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) of the Province of Pangasinan.

Section 2. Objective. It is the objective of the Provincial Government to support the policies and programs of the National Government by having a detailed plan route network with specific modes of transportation and the required number of units per mode for delivering land transport services in the Province of Pangasinan.

Section 3. Scope and Coverage. This ordinance shall apply to the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Pangasinan comprising of 44 municipalities and 3 cities.

Section 4. Legal Framework and Composition of the LPTRP Team. Pursuant to JMC 001, S-2017 of the DOTr and the DILG, the Local Public Transport Route Plan Committee was organized through Executive Order No. 0178-2022 composed of the following:

Section 6. Assessment/Updating of the LPTRP. The approved LPTRP of the Province shall be subject to assessment/revalidation after six (6) months and be updated at least once every three (3) years from the date of issuance of the Notice of Compliance.

Section 7. Separability Clause. – If any section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other sections or provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force or effect.


Section 8. Repealing Clause. – All other ordinances, orders, issuances, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
