APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2023-098 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF TAYUG, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL AIP PURSUANT TO APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2023-002 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYUG, PANGASINAN INVOLVING AN AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS AND 59/100 (P5,769,380.59)”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Tayug, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 2023-098 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991. The Local Development Council of Tayug, Pangasinan has identified items in their Supplemental Annual Investment Program. This was endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan on October 12, 2023 through MDC Resolution No. 2023-04;
2. The SIP of the municipality covers fund augmentation for the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of some municipal offices and the implementation of development program (purchased of land for housing projects) of LGU Tayug;

3. Funding support for the proposed SAIP, with a total investment requirement of PhP5,769,380.59 is embodied in the municipality's Supplemental Budget No.2, which was approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2023-002 on October 23, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Tayug, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Noel C. Bince and Salvador S. Perez, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., Joyce D. Fernandez and Maria Doriza V. Ramos, duly seconded, it was—


