RESOLUTION NO. 96-2024

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 087-2023 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LABRADOR, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 4 FOR CY 2023 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LABRADOR, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Labrador, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 087-2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. The Municipal Development Council of Labrador, Pangasinan prepared their Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 4 for CY 2023. This is in accordance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;
2. Said Supplemental AIP, which has an investment requirement of ₱1,000,000.00, covers the implementation of the project, Construction of Residual Waste Containment Facility of the LGU;
3. The proposed project to be funded from the savings of the 20% Development Fund for CY 2023, in the amount of P 1,000,000.00, conforms with Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects); and



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4. Funding for the implementation of this Supplemental AIP is embodied in their Supplemental Budget No. 4, FY 2023, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 04-2023, dated December 4, 2023 and approved by the Municipal Mayor on December 5, 2023.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Labrador, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Philip Theodore E. Cruz and Haidee S. Pacheco and co-sponsored by SP Members Arthur C. Celeste, Jr., Joyce D. Fernandez and Maria Doriza V. Ramos, duly seconded, it was—


RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 087-2023 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Labrador, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 4 for CY 2023 of the Municipality of Labrador, Pangasinan”;
