RESOLUTION NO. 598-2024

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-303 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF STA. BARBARA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 2024-01 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF STA. BARBARA, PANGASINAN FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024, REQUIRING A TOTAL FUNDING OF EIGHT MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETY FIVE THOUSAND TEN PESOS AND EIGHT CENTAVOS (P8,695,010.08)”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 2024-303 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. The Municipal Development Council of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan prepared the LGU’s Supplemental Investment Program (SIP) No. 2024-01, CY 2024. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 2024-01, Series of 2024 dated February 19, 2024, to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This is in accordance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;



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2. Said Supplemental AIP, which has a total investment requirement of P8,695,010.08, covers fund augmentation for Personal Services, Maintenance and other Operating Expenses and Capital Outlay of the LGU, and implementation of DRRM programs/projects and GAD related projects/activities of the municipality. The projects proposed to be funded from the 5% LDRRM Fund conform with Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 of the NDRRMC, DBM & DILG, dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund); and
3. Funding for the full implementation of this Supplemental AIP is embodied in their Supplemental Budget No. 01, FY 2024, which was enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2024-036, dated March 18, 2024.




