**RESOLUTION NO. 114-2025**

**APPROVING SB RESOLUTION NO. 162, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN”**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 162, S-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject Resolution is in consonance to Section 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991. The Municipal Development Council of Malasiqui, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2025. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 02-2024, Series of 2024 dated October 10, 2024, and was favorably acted upon by the Sangguniang Bayan through SB Resolution No. 162-2024 dated November 4, 2024;
2. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2023 Edition, and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007, DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by



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DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-1 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Malasiqui is categorized into general public, social, economic and other services sectors, and covers: (a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Services (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, (b) priority development programs/projects of the LGU, including those funded by the 20% Development Fund, (c) Disaster-Risk Reduction Management (DRRM) programs, projects, and activities, and (d) activities in pursuance of the objectives of GAD of the LGU;

Also attached to the AIP, among others, are the following: (a) Local Climate Change Action Plan, (b) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, (c) List of PPAs for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities, (d) List of PPAs to Combat AIDS, (e) Peace and Order Plan and Public Safety Plan, (f) Annual Cultural Development Plan, (g) Nutrition Action Plan, (h) Local Youth Development Plan, and (i) List of PPAs Addressing Illegal Drugs of the LGU;

It is recommended, however, that the new prescribed AIP Summary Form be used by the LGU in their succeeding AIPs and Supplemental AIPs as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 87 dated June 9, 2023;

3. The AIP of Malasiqui for CY 2025, which has a total investment requirement of P542,600,608.89, will be funded by the LGU as embodied in their 2025 Annual Budget approved and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 002-2024, dated November 4, 2024;
4. Said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of LGC of 1991. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGU's IRA/NTA (P489,205,369.00), amounting to P97,841,073.80, is allocated for development projects. The development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% Development Fund were based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects);
5. The attached Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the LGU amounting to P27,130,068.45 conform with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects to be funded from the 70% of the LDRRMF, in the amount of P18,991,047.92 are based on



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the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund) and the 30% amounting to P8,139,020.53 is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF); The LDRRM Plan of the LGU was forwarded to the Office of Civil Defense-Regional Office I for their review/evaluation as per attachment;

6. The LGU of Malasiqui had also identified programs, projects and activities which are responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP. This is in pursuance to DBM-CCC-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015; and
7. The Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and approved by the DILG Provincial Office, and found to be compliant in form and content with the provisions of PCW-DILG-DBM-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular Nos. 2013-01 and 2016-01(Guidelines on the Localization of the Magna Carta of Women).

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of Malasiqui, Pangasinan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventenilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve SB Resolution No. 162, S-2024 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, entitled “Approving the Annual Investment Program (AIP) for Calendar Year 2025 of the Municipality of Malasiqui, Pangasinan”;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
