RESOLUTION NO. 44-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 299, S-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MAPANDAN, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN (AIP) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAPANDAN, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mapandan, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 299, S-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SB Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject Resolution is in consonance to Section 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991. The Municipal Development Council of Mapandan, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2025. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan through MDC Resolution No. 5, S. 2024 dated August 19, 2024;
2. The Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2023 Edition, and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007, DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2014-01 dated August 7, 2014, as amended by DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-1 dated July 23, 2015 as to format content. The AIP Mapandan is categorized into general public, social,



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economic and other services sectors, and covers (a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay, (b) priority development programs/projects of the LGU, including those funded by the 20% Development Fund, (c) Disaster-Risk Reduction (DRR) programs, projects, and activities, and (d) activities in pursuance of the objectives of Gender and Development (GAD) of the LGU as indicated in the DILG-endorsed GAD Plan and Budget. Also attached to the IAP, among others, are the following: (a) Local Climate Change Plan, (b) Annual Cultural Development Plan, (c) List of Programs Projects and Activities (PPAs) for the Protection of Children, (d) List of PPAs for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, (e) Local Youth Development Plan, (f) Action Plan for STI/HIV/AIDS, (g) Peace and Order Plan/Localized Anti-Criminality Action Plan, (h) Municipal Anti-Drug Action Plan and (i) Annual Procurement Plan of the LGU. It is recommended however, that the new prescribed AIP Summary Form be used by the LGU in their succeeding AIPs and Supplemental AIPs as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 87 dated June 9, 2023;

3. The proposed AIP of Mapandan has a total investment requirement of P193,088,074.00 which will be financed by the LGU as embodied in their FY 2025 Annual Budget, and enacted by their Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2024 dated September 23, 2024 and approved by the Municipal Mayor on October 21, 2024;
4. Said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of LGC of 1991. More than twenty percent (20.03%) of the LGU's IRA/NTA (P171,997,074.00), amounting to P34,458,787.24, is allocated for development projects. The development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% Development Fund were based on the Joint DBM-DOF-DILG Memorandum Circular No.1 dated November 4, 2020 (Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual National Tax Allocation for Development Projects);
5. The attached Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Programs/Projects/Activities in preparation for and to mitigate the impact of disasters to be funded by the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund of the LGU amounting to P9,274,403.70 conform with Section 21 of RA 10121. The programs/projects to be funded from the 70% of the LDRRMF, in the amount of P6,492,082.59 are based on the NDRRMC-DBM and DILG Joint Memo Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 (Allocation and Utilization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund) and the 30% amounting to P2,782,321.11, is allocated for Quick Response Fund (QRF). The LGU's LDRRM Fund Investment Plan was already reviewed and evaluated by the Office of the Civil



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Defense – Regional Office I through the Local DRRM Plan (2021-2026) of the Municipality;

6. The LGU of Mapandan had also identified programs, projects and activities which are responsive to Climate Change and tagged its corresponding expenditures in their AIP; and
7. The Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2025 of the LGU was reviewed and approved by the DILG Provincial Office, and found to be compliant in form and content with the provisions of the PCW-DILG-DBM-NEDA Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) Nos. 2013-01 and 2016-01 (Guidelines on the Localization of the Magna Carta of Women).


