RESOLUTION NO. 293-2025

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 160-2024 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 3 CY 2024 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN JACINTO, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of San Jacinto, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 160-2024 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Coordinator have conducted initial review and study on said Resolution with the following findings:

- 1. The Municipal Development Council of San Jacinto, Pangasinan prepared the municipality's Supplemental Investment Program No. 3 for CY 2024. This was endorsed by the Council, through MDC Resolution No. 2024-3 dated December 20, 2024 and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan on December 23, 2024. This is in accordance with Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code of 1991;
- 2. The Supplemental AIP, which has a total investment requirement of ₱14,592,076.00, covers the augmentation of funds for Personal Services (granting of Service Recognition Incentives to qualified LGU personnel), and Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses and implementation of infrastructure projects in support to tobacco farmer and DRRM Program of the LGU;

- 3. The projects proposed to be funded from the Tobacco Excise Tax Share of the LGU in the amount of P6,860,576.00 conform with Local Budget Memorandum (LBM) No. 91 dated August 29, 2024 of the DBM;
- 4. The LGU also allocated 5% from the Tobacco Excise Tax to the LDRRM Fund as provided for in the same LBM. However, it is respectfully recommended that the LGU identify the project/s to be funded by the 5% LDRRM Fund; and
- 5. Funding support for the Supplemental AIP is embodied in the LGU's Supplemental Budget No. 3, CY 2024, which was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2024-04, Series of 2024, dated December 23, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Government of San Jacinto, Pangasinan;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Marinor B. De Guzman and Jerry Agerico B. Rosario and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to approve Resolution No. 160-2024 of the Sangguniang Bayan of San Jacinto, Pangasinan, entitled "Approving the Supplemental Investment Program No. 3 for CY 2024 of the Municipality of San Jacinto, Pangasinan";
