RESOLUTION NO. 308-2025

DECLARING THE SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 6 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 OF STA. BARBARA, PANGASINAN, INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P22,966,749.00, OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan submitted its Supplemental Budget No. 6 for Calendar Year 2024 involving a total appropriation of P22,966,749.00, which was enacted on December 19, 2024 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 2024-055;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee of the Province pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted review and study on said budget with the following findings:

1. That all programs, projects and activities shall be in accordance with the approved Local Development Plan and the FY 2024 Annual Investment Program of the municipality and its supplements thereto, formulated pursuant to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, Series of 2007 dated March 8, 2007;

- 2. That utilization of appropriations from FY 2022 shares of the Municipality from the Burley and Native Tobacco Excise Tax Collections under R.A. No. 8240 shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Memorandum No. 91 dated August 29, 2024;
- That the LGU failed to set aside appropriation for 5% calamity fund on its newly sourced income. The LGU already stated that they will make amends and provide for such appropriation in its next supplemental budget;
- 4. That the grant of Service Recognition Incentive shall be in accordance with Budget Circular 2024-07 dated December 16, 2024 in consonance with Administrative Order 27 dated December 12, 2024;
- 5. That the funding sources for the subject supplemental budget were determined in accordance to Section 321 of R.A. 7160 and Article 414(a) of its IRR as amended by Administrative Order No. 47 dated April 12, 1993; and
- 6. That all procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Shiela Marie F. Baniqued and Vici M. Ventanilla and co-sponsored by SP Members Carolyn D. Sison, Joyce D. Fernandez and Raul R. Sabangan, duly seconded, it was—

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Operative in its Entirety Supplemental Budget No. 6 for Calendar Year 2024 of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
