Dear Ma'am:

Reference is made to your indorsement dated May 15, 2023, which was received by this office on May 24, 2023, requesting for legal opinion and recommendation on Executive Order No. _______ entitled: "AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PROVINCIAL INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE ON ANTITRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (PIACAT-VAWC) IN THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN".

With all due respect, this office observes minor typographical errors and possible omission of words/ phrases in the previous submission dated May 15, 2023. Thereafter, we received a copy of the new version on June 19, 2023, and it appears that our previous observations and recommendations were duly considered.

The PIACAT-VAWC was established by virtue of Republic Act No. 9262 known as the "Anti-Violence Against Women and Their Children Act of 2004", to ensure effective implementation of the law and be the lead coordinator and monitoring body on VAWC initiatives.

Section 2 of the same law provides:

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy - It is hereby declared that the State values the dignity of women and children and guarantees full respect for human rights. The State also recognizes the need to protect the family and its members particularly women and children, from violence and threats to their personal safety and security.

Towards this end, the State shall exert efforts to address violence committed against women and children in keeping with the fundamental freedoms guaranteed under the Constitution and the Provisions of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the convention on the Elimination of all forms of discrimination Against Women, Convention on the Rights of the Child and other international human rights instruments of which the Philippines is a party.

Moreover, it can be justified under the following provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, to quote:

Sec. 465. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions, and Compensation xxx.

- (b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the province and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the provincial governor shall:
- (1) Exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the provincial government, and in this connection, shall:
- (ii) Direct the formulation of the provincial development plan, with the assistance of the provincial development council, and upon approval thereof by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, implement the same;
- (2) Enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the province and the exercise of the appropriate corporate powers provided for under Section 22 of this Code, implement all approved policies, programs, projects, services and activities of the province and, in addition to the foregoing, shall:
- (iii) Issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;"

Premises considered, undersigned finds no legal impediments in the provisions of the subject Executive Order, and we respectfully recommend the execution/ signing of the same.
