APPROVING SB RESOLUTION NO. 186-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG **BAYAN** OF MALASIQUI. PANGASINAN. ENTITLED "APPROVING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2020 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan submitted its SB Resolution No. 186-2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the same is in consonance to Sections 106, 109, 114 of RA 7160. The Municipal Development Council of Malasiqui, Pangasinan had identified and prioritized programs and projects in their Annual Investment Program for CY 2020. This was endorsed by the Council to the Sangguniang Bayan thru MDC Resolution No. 03-2019 dated October 17, 2019 and was favorably acted upon by the Sangguniang Bayan on November 27, 2019 thru SB Resolution No. 186-2019;

WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program of the municipality is in accordance with the Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for Local Government Units, 2016 Edition and in pursuance to DILG-NEDA-DBM-DOF Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 1, S-2007 dated March 8, 2007 and DBM-CCC-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 dated July 23, 2015 as to format and content. The AIP of Malasiqui, Pangasinan was prepared using the prescribed AIP Summary Form, and covers: a) all the regular budgetary requirements for the operation of the different offices broken down into: Personal Services (PS), Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses

(MOOE) and Capital Outlay, b) the priority development programs/projects of the LGU including those to be funded by the 20% development fund, c) Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Programs/Projects/Activities, and d) Activities in pursuance of the objectives of GAD of the LGU. Also attached to the AIP, among others, are the following: a) Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) to be funded by external sources b) Local Climate Change Action Plan c) Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan, d) List of Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) for the Local Council for the Protection of Children, e) List of PPAs for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities f) Annual Cultural Development Plan and g); Nutrition Plan;

WHEREAS, the AIP of Malasiqui for CY 2020 has a total investment requirement of P377,150,126.00. Of this, a sum of P366,097,221.00 will be financed by the LGU as embodied in their 2020 Annual Budget passed and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan through Appropriation Ordinance No. 005, S-2019 dated November 27, 2019. The remaining amount will be sourced from the Local Government Support Fund-Assistance to Municipalities (LGSF-AM) and Performance Challenge Fund (PCF) amounting to a total of P11,052,905.00;

WHEREAS, said AIP is in accordance with Section 287 of RA 7160. Twenty percent (20%) of the LGUs IRA (P301,883,864.00), amounting to P60,376,772.80 is allocated for development projects;

WHEREAS, the development projects proposed to be funded by the 20% development fund were based on the DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2017-1, dated February 22, 2017 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for Development Projects";

WHEREAS, the projects and activities included in the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Investment Plan amounting to P17,614,193.20 were based on Section 21 of RA 10121 and Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 of the NDRMMC, DBM & DILG dated March 25, 2013 (Joint Allocation and Utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund). However, the LRRM Plan shall still be submitted by the municipality to the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) for review as per Local Budget Memorandum No. 77 dated May 15, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Gender and Development Plan and Budget for CY 2019 of the LGU has been reviewed and approved DILG Provincial Office, and found to be fully compliant in form and in contents with the provisions of the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2016-01 entitled "Amendments to JMC 2013-01 or the Guidelines on the Localization of Magna Carta of Women";
