PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 111-2004

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE 5TH SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF PANGASINAN FOR JULY 2004 TO JUNE 2007

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan in session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Standing committees are hereby created by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan for 2004-2007, composed of at least seven (7) members, including the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and the automatic members drawn from the Sanggunian membership, and assigned to address specific area(s) of legislation; provided, however, that no member shall be chairman of more than one (1) regular committee or vice chairman of more than two (2) regular committees except those who are automatic members of said committees;

Section 2. Committees shall meet at the call of their respective chairman or majority of their members;

Section 3. A majority of the members of a committee shall constitute a quorum to do business. Unexplained absences in four (4) consecutive committee meetings shall operate to relinquish membership therein;

Section 4. Standing committees shall remain operative during the term of the 5th Sangguniang Panlalawigan and shall serve as miniature legislative body whose membership and general jurisdiction are fixed and specified in the Internal Rules of Procedure of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

Section 5. Unless otherwise provided, the following standing committees are hereby created for the specified purposes and shall exercise and discharge such functions and powers as thereby provided in the Internal Rules of Procedure:

- 1. Rules, Laws, Ordinances and Privileges
- 2. Good Government and Accountability of Public Officers
- 3. Monetary and Economic Affairs and Public Services
- 4. Agriculture, Food and Agrarian Reform
- 5. Environment and Natural Resources
- 6. Education, Arts and Culture
- 7. Youth and Sports
- 8. Senior Citizens
- 9. Women and Family Affairs
- 10. Barangay Affairs and Peace and Public Safety
- 11. Housing, Land Utilization and Energy
- 12. Tourism
- 13. Public Works, Infrastructure, and Labor
- 14. Health, Social Welfare and Development
- 15. Trade and Cooperatives
- 16. Justice and Human Rights

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed repealed or amended accordingly;
