EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY AND SINCEREST CONDOLENCES TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE LATE FRANCISCO SIONIL JOSE, ONE OF THE RENOWNED NATIONAL ARTISTS OF THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, one of the illustrious sons of the Province of Pangasinan, Francisco Sionil Jose, peacefully joined his Creator at the age of 97 last January 6, 2022;

WHEREAS, during his lifetime, the late Francisco Sionil Jose, also known as F. Sionil Jose, had epitomized the story of a Pangasinense's excellence in the field of literature;

WHEREAS, the late Francisco Sionil Jose was a multi-awarded writer and among his outstanding works were *The God Stealer* in 1959, *Waywaya* in 1979, *Arbol de Fuego* (Firetree) in 1980, his novel *Mass* in 1981, and his essay *A Scenario for Philippine Resistance* in 1979 but the most popular of which is the Rosales Saga which comprised of five novels, namely: Po-on; The Pretenders; My Brother, My Executioner; Mass; and Tree;

WHEREAS, the late Francisco Sionil Jose had received recognition from several award-giving bodies like the Carlos Palanca Memorial Awards for Literature, Ramon Magsaysay Award for Journalism, Literature and Creative Communication Arts, Cultural Center of the Philippines' Centennial Awards, France's Chevalier dans I'Ordre des Arts et Lettres, and Pablo Neruda Centennial Award;

WHEREAS, in 2004, the national government bestowed upon him the prestigious title of National Artist for Literature for his exceptional contributions to Philippine literature;
