THIS IS TO CERTIFY that at the regular session duly constituted of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Province of Pangasinan held on July 20, 1992, at Lingayen, Pangasinan, the following Ordinance was approved:

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 15-92

RE-NAMING THE PROVINCIAL POPULATION RESPONSIBLE PARENTHOOD INTO PROVINCIAL POPULATION OFFICE

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled that:

- SECTION 1 The Office of Provincial Population and Responsible Parenthood is hereby renamed as Provincial Population Office;
- SECTION 2 Effective upon approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan the salaries and other remunerations of the Provincial Population Officer and the personnel complement and other operating expenses in the above-mentioned renamed office in Section I of this Ordinance, shall be appropriated and included in the annual budget;
- SECTION 3 The re-naming of the aforecited Office is urgently needed in order to implement the Constitutional provisions relative to population development and the promotion of responsible parenthood in the Province, to carry out measures to ensure the delivery of basic services relative to the integration of the population development principles; to establish and maintain and updated data bank for program operations, development planning and educational program to ensure the People's participation and understudy of population development to implement appropriate training program responsive to the cultural heritage of the inhabitants in Pangasinan; and, to exercise such other functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance.

SECTION 4 - Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
