THIS IS TO CERTIFY that at the regular session duly constituted of the Sangguniang Panlalawinan, Province of Pangasinan, held on October 9, 1992, at Lingayen, Pangasinan, the following resolution was approved:

RESOLUTION NO. 102

RE-ESTABLISHING THE PANGASINAN PROVINCIAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, PROVIDING THE MECHANISM FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION AND APPROPRIATING THE MECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR

MHEREAS, the Constitution of the Philippines, under Section 17, Article II and Section 2 and 3, Article XIV mandates that education of the youth is a primary concern of government;

WHEREAS, no less than His Excellency, our very own President Fidel V. Ramos, has committed the national government to the full observance and implementation of said constitutional mandate;

MALEREAS, the Provincial Government of Pangasinan can do no less but to share in this constitutional responsibility by way of re-establishing its Scholarship Program which was scrapped during the previous administration for lack of funds;

MEREAS, one of the most effective ways of implementing the aforesaid scholarship program is the purchase of educational plans assuring college education to its beneficiaries;

support and assistance of His Excellency, President Fidel V. Ramos, to augment its resources by allocating from the President's Social Amelioration Fund such amount as maybe sufficient to purchase educational funds for FIVE THOUSAND (5000) beneficiaries of the Scholarship Program to be selected from all the barangays of the province;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Editha G. Demetria and Alfonso C. Bince, Jr., duly seconded by SP Members Dionisio C. Antiniw and Leonardo S. Caranto, it was -

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang in session assembled to:

 Re-establish the Pangasinan Provincial Scholarship Assistance Program thru the purchase of educational plans;

- 2. To seek the assistance and support of His Excellency, President Fidel V. Ramos for augmentation of its resources by allocation from his Social Amelioration Fund such amount as maybe sufficient to purchase educational plans to benefit FIVE THOUSAND (5000) scholars;
- 3. To approve the accompanying Ordinance implementing above resolution, as follows:

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 17-92

AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING THE FANGASIMAN PROVINCIAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM THRU THE PURCHASE OF EDUCATIONAL PLANS, PROVIDING THE MECHANISM FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE

- SECTION 1 Short Title PANGASIMAN PROVINCIAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- SECTION 2 Purpose and Scope To support and finance FIVE THOUGAND (5000) poor but deserving young boys and girls in all the barangays of the province in completing a 5-year college course thru the purchase of educational plans;
- SECTION 3 Scholars The beneficiaries will be screened and selected by a Scholarship Committee to be constituted by the Provincial Governor, in consultation with the Sanggunian Panlalawigan and will be called the "Provincial Echolars";

The Scholarship Committee shall promulgated the rules and regulations regarding the scholarship program;

That with respect to the actual grant or execution of the policies and rules promulgated by the Sanggunian that it be administered by the Provincial Scholarship Board to be headed by the Provincial Governor as the Chairman, at least one from the SP Tembers, preferably the Chairman of the Committee on Education to sit as member together with other Heads of line agencies connected with education;

- SECTION 4 Criteria The grant of scholarship be vested in the Committee on Education subject to concurrence by the Sangguniang annial awigan rule making is basically a legislative power;
- SECTION 5 Authority of the Provincial Governor The Provincial Governor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract execute and sign any and/or all necessary documents with any educational plan association and/or comporation for the immediate realization of the program, subject to confirmation by the Sanggunian Panlalawigan;

SECTION 6 - Appropriations - All unappropriated surplus of the last preceding year budget, contribution and donations for the purpose and such available funds realizable in the current revenue collections are hereby appropriated for the program;

SECTION 7 - Date of Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
