PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 203-2016

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE AGUEDO F. AGBAYANI PARK INTO GOVERNORS PARK

WHEREAS, the Province of Pangasinan, considered as the premier province of Region I, is privileged to have been endowed with exceptional leaders;

WHEREAS, up to the present, there are about 28 Governors who have served this great Province from the time of Governor Perfecto Sison, the first Governor of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, the outstanding achievements and excellent performances of the past and present Governors of the Province of Pangasinan have contributed immensely to the socio-economic development and political stability and maturity of this great Province;

WHEREAS, it is the clamor of the people of the Province of Pangasinan to establish a Governors Park within the Capitol Compound in honor of all the Governors who had served and will serve this Province considering that there is a limited space along the area where to establish another park except that of the Aguedo F. Agbayani Park;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Governors Park, in lieu of the Aguedo F. Agbayani Park, is a fitting tribute and acknowledgment to the untiring efforts of all the Governors of Pangasinan in vigorously pushing through the various government developmental programs of this Province;


WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Nestor D. Reyes and co-authored by SP Members Noel C. Bince, Jeremy Agerico B. Rosario and Napoleon C. Fontelera, Jr., duly seconded –

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “An Ordinance Renaming the Aguedo F. Agbayani Park into Governors Park”.

SECTION 2. The renaming of the Aguedo F. Agbayani Park into Governors Park is an act to commemorate the remarkable contributions of the past, present and future Governors of this Province toward the achievement of progress and development.


