RESOLUTION NO. 314-2021

DECLARING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2021 OF SUAL, PANGASINAN INVOLVING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF P398,000,000.00 OPERATIVE IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan as a legislative body of the Province is empowered to review ordinances authorizing annual or supplemental appropriations of component cities and municipalities in the manner prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Sual, Pangasinan submitted its Annual Budget for Calendar Year 2021 involving total appropriations of **P398,000,000.00** which was approved on December 14, 2020 through Appropriation Ordinance No. 01;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Local Finance Committee pursuant to Section 316 of the Local Government Code of 1991, have conducted preliminary review and study on said budget with the following findings:

- 1. The appropriations for the implementation of the Second Tranche Compensation Adjustment shall be subject to the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 132 dated January 6, 2021 re Implementation of the Second Tranche of the Modified Salary Schedule for Local Government Personnel pursuant to Republic Act No. 11466;
- 2. The projects funded under the 20% of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for development projects (20% Development Fund) shall be subject to the provisions of DBM-DOF-DILG JMC No. 1 dated November 4, 2020, Re: Revised Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the twenty percent (20%) of the Annual Internal Revenue Allotment for Development Projects;

- 3. The items funded out of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund shall be in accordance with RA No. 10121 known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 and its IRR and the DBM-NDRRM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2013-1 dated March 25, 2013 re: Allocation and Utilization of the Local Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF);
- 4. All procurements to be undertaken shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of RA No. 9184 (The Government Procurement Reform Act) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;
- 5. The Productivity Enhancement Incentive (PEI) in the amount of P5,000.00 each may be granted to qualified personnel not earlier than December 15 of every year, subject to the rules and regulations provided under Budget Circular No. 2017-4 dated December 04, 2017;
- 6. The position title of the following should be changed pursuant to Budget Circular No. 2004-3 dated March 6, 2004 entitled "Conversion of Positions Performing Staff/Non-Technical Functions":

- 7. The purchase of motor vehicle shall be in accordance with the provisions of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2021-04 dated January 18, 2021;
- 8. The appropriation for Consultancy Services shall be used strictly for the professional service fees of consultants/experts who will provide highly specialized or technical expertise that cannot be provided by the regular staff of Municipal Government; *and*
- 9. The following budget documents shall be included in the appropriation ordinance:
 - a. Summary of new appropriations by object of expenses and by sector
 - b. Summary of new appropriations by Department/Office
 - c. Summary Statement of all Statutory and Contractual Obligations Due

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the same in order provided that the findings shall be complied with by the municipality and shall notify the offices concerned of the actions taken thereon;
