TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that at the regular session duly constituted of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Province of Pangasinan, held on January 28, 1994, at Lingayen, Pangasinan, the following Provincial Ordinance was approved:

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 35

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M. GARCIA ST., (MANAOAG-URDANETA PROVINCIAL ROAD) TO ALLOW THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE ISLAND OR MEDIAN BARRIER WITH PLANTING OF ORNAMENTAL PLANTS AND INSTALLIATION OF LIGHTING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21 (a) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction, Provided, however, that in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the Members of the Sangguniang and when necessary, an adequate substitute for public facility that is subject to closure is provided;

WHEREAS, Mayor Pedro N. Sales of Manaoag in his letter dated May 26, 1993, sought permission to construct a concrete island in the Poblacion, along the M. Garcia St. within the Manaoag-Urdaneta Poblacion Road;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member Dionisio C. Antiniw, co-authored by SP Members Conrado P. Gubatan and Ramon T. Bautista, duly seconded, it was -

Be it enacted in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The temporary closure of the M. Garcia St., along the Manaoag-Urdaneta Provincial Road is hereby authorized subject to the following conditions to wit:

- 1. The municipal government of Manaoag shall, during the construction of the concrete island, install appropriate warning sign-boards within the jobsite at its own expense for the safety of the general public;
- 2. Any damage to the road pavement during the project's implementation should be restored to its original condition at the expense of the municipal government of Manaoag, subject to the supervision and approval of the Provincial Engineer;

- 3. Proper construction methods and engineering practices shall be strictly followed; and
- 4. The municipal government of Manaoag shall coordinate with the Office of the Provincial Engineer at least two (2) days before the implementation of the above project, upon approval of this ordinance by the Provincial Governor;

SECTION 2. The duration of the closure of said postion of the Manaoag-Urdaneta Provincial Road will be specified by the Provincial Governor in a written order;

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
