APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 560, S-2019-22 OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF URDANETA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED “APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) NO. 11 OF URDANETA FOR CY 2021 IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (P4,760,000.00)”

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Urdaneta, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 560, S-2019-22 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of Republic Act No.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer have conducted initial review and study on said SP Resolution with the following findings:

1. Subject resolution is in consonance to Sections 106, 109 and 114 of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991. The Local Development Council of Urdaneta City, Pangasinan had identified items in their Supplemental Investment Program No. 11 for CY 2021. This was endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval on September 17, 2021 by the City Development Council Resolution No. 10-2021;

2. The Supplemental Investment Program No. 11 of the city covers fund augmentation for the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of some city offices and implementation of Medicare Para sa Masa/AICS; and
3. Funding support for the implementation of the same in the amount of P4,760,000.00 is embodied in their proposed Supplemental Budget No. 10 for CY 2021 which was enacted by their Sangguniang Panlungsod through Appropriation Ordinance No. 64, Series of 2019-22 on December 21, 2021.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order, however, compliance with all the existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the City Government of Urdaneta, Pangasinan;


