**RESOLUTION NO. 488-2020**

**DECLARING ORDINANCE NO. 116, S-2019 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BASISTA, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE COMPELLING STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF MOTHER-BABY FRIENDLY HEALTH INSTITUTIONS IN BASISTA, PANGASINAN FOR THE PROMOTION AND SUPPORT OF BREASTFEEDING POLICY, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" AS WITHIN THE CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan of Basista, Pangasinan submitted its Ordinance No. 116, Series of 2019 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 17 (iii) and Section 447 (a) (vi) of RA 7160; World Health Assembly Resolution No. 34-22 also known as "The International Code of Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes of 1981; and Republic Act No. 7600 (The Roaming-In and Breastfeeding Act of 1992) as amended by RA No. 10028 (Expanded Breastfeeding Promotion Act of 2009);

**WHEREAS**, subject ordinance shall take effect after the requirements of posting and publication pursuant to Sections 59 (c) and 511 (a) of RA 7160 are complied with by the Sangguniang Bayan;

**WHEREFORE**, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Nestor D. Reyes and Von Mark R. Mendoza and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –




