BAYABAN, JR. OF ASINGAN, PANGASINAN FOR BEING  
ONE OF THE ARTISTS IN THE VOICE KIDS 2019 WHO  
ADVANCED TO THE LIVE SHOWS STAGE OF THE  
SINGING COMPETITION**

**WHEREAS**, The Voice Kids is a Philippine reality singing television competition on ABS-CBN based on the Dutch reality singing competition of the same name that initially aired on May 24, 2014 in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, in the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of The Voice Kids, which premiered on August 3, 2019 with Lea Salonga, Bamboo Mañalac, and Sarah Geronimo as coaches, Yvanie Jeush “Vanjoss” Bayaban, Jr., a 12-year old Grade 7 student of Angela Valdez National High School in Asingan, Pangasinan, and the son of Bayani Bayaban, a welder, and Evelyn Bayaban, an overseas Filipino worker in Hong Kong, was a 3-chair turner during the Blind Auditions for impressively reaching the F# tone without exerting much effort;

**WHEREAS**, under the mentorship of Sarah Geronimo whom he has chosen as his coach, Vanjoss Bayaban, Jr. won the Battles and advanced to the Sing-offs on October 6, 2019, and on October 12, 2019, Vanjoss was picked by his coach in the Sing-offs and advanced to the Live-shows or the semi-finals round of the competition;

**WHEREAS**, Vanjoss Bayaban, Jr. learned to sing at an early age of four by watching singing contests in television with his father as one way of honing his singing skills;

**WHEREAS**, with his father as his singing teacher, Vanjoss was a frequent contender in amateur singing contests, and before joining The Voice Kids he was the first runner-up winner in the Ugugaw Category of the Province’s *Takayan na Dayew* 2019;
