PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 662-2021

URGING THE NATIONAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE ON EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES (IATF-EID) TO CONSIDER GIVING PRIORITY TO PNP PERSONNEL FRONTLINERS IN THE ONGOING COVID-19 VACCINATION DRIVE

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 vaccination program of the national government continues to cover more individuals in the localities for the inoculation of identified priority population;

WHEREAS, frontline health workers, senior citizens and persons with comorbidities and others which are listed on the top list have already been vaccinated;

WHEREAS, frontline personnel in essential sectors which include uniformed personnel are included in the next category of the priority list of the COVID-19 vaccination program;

WHEREAS, law enforcement frontliners are at high risk of exposure since they are dealing with a lot of people during their call of duty;

WHEREAS, prioritizing them also would lessen the mortality and morbidity rate for men in uniform during this period of public health crisis especially now that local cases of the COVID-19 Delta variant have already been detected in some parts of the country;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 vaccination is a safer way to help build protection toward a severe infection for everybody especially the PNP personnel frontliners who continue to enforce the government's ongoing efforts to contain the further spread of the disease more so in the fight against the highly infectious Delta variant;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Jeremy Agerico B. Rosario, duly seconded, it was –

RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan in ssession assembled to urge, as it is hereby urged, the National Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) to consider giving priority to PNP personnel frontliners in the ongoing COVID-19 vaccination drive;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the National Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases, for its information and favorable consideration.
