APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 17, S-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF VILLASIS, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 1 OF FISCAL YEAR 2020 FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY ONE PESOS AND 57/100 (P20,369,891.57) AND ASSISTANCE TO MUNICIPALITIES (AM) FROM NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AMOUNTING TO SEVEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE THOUSAND PESOS (P7,983,000.00) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLASIS, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Villasis, Pangasinan submitted its Resolution No. 17, Series of 2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Planning and Development Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said resolution and found out that the Local Development Council of Villasis, Pangasinan has formulated and endorsed the municipality's Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 01 thru MDC Executive Committee Resolution No. 02-2020 dated February 27, 2020 to the Sangguniang Bayan for approval. This was approved by their Sangguniang Bayan on March 17, 2020 through Resolution No. 17, S-2020. This is in pursuance to Sections 106, 109, and 114 of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 01 has total investment requirement amounting to P28,252,891.57. Of this, P20,369,891.57 covers fund augmentation for PS, MOOE and implementation of development projects of the municipality. This will be funded by the Supplemental Budget No. 1 which was enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan thru Appropriation Ordinance No. 01 dated March 17, 2020. The remaining amount of P7,983,000.00 which covers the implementation of Local Access Road Program will be funded by the National Government under Assistance to Municipality Program;


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, after final evaluation, finds the subject resolution in order;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Rosary Gracia P. Perez-Tababa and Nicholi Jan Louie Q. Sison and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –


