## **RESOLUTION NO. 766-2020**

DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 009-2020 OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MALASIQUI, PANGASINAN, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON FROM COMMITTING ANY ACT WHICH CAUSES STIGMA, DISGRACE, HUMILIATION, HARASSMENT OR OTHERWISE SHAME, DISCRIMINATING AGAINST A PERSON INFECTED, UNDER **INVESTIGATION OR MONITORING DUE TO THE COVID-19** VIRUS INCLUDING PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PHYSICIANS, NURSES, HEALTH WORKERS, EMERGENCY PERSONNEL AND **VOLUNTEERS, SERVICE WORKERS WHO ARE ASSIGNED TO** HOSPITALS OR OTHER CENTERS WHERE THESE PERSONS ARE TREATED, INCLUDING BEING THEIR FAMILIES AND **RELATIVES, AND IMPOSING THE APPROPRIATE PENALTIES** THEREIN, HEREIN OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ANTI-COVID **19 DISCRIMINATION ORDINANCE OF 2020" AS WITHIN THE** CONFERRED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO ENACT

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan submitted its Municipal Ordinance No. 009-2020 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and evaluation pursuant to Section 56 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Laws and Ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, with the technical assistance of the Provincial Legal Officer, have conducted initial review and study on said municipal ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 447 (a) (1) (iii), (5) (xii) of RA 7160; and Section 5 of the Omnibus Guidelines in the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, subject ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the requirements of posting and publication pursuant to Sections 59 (c) and 511 (a) of RA 7160;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Members Vici M. Ventanilla and Angel M. Baniqued, Jr. and co-sponsored by SP Members Sheila Marie S. Perez-Galicia, Jerome Vic O. Espino and Jose G. Peralta, Jr., duly seconded, it was –

**RESOLVED**, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled, to declare Municipal Ordinance No. 009-2020 of the Sangguniang Bayan of **Malasiqui**, Pangasinan, entitled "An Ordinance prohibiting any person from committing any act which causes stigma, disgrace, shame, humiliation, harassment or otherwise discriminating against a person infected, under investigation or monitoring due to the COVID-19 virus including public and private physicians, nurses, health workers, emergency personnel and volunteers, service workers who are assigned to hospitals or other centers where these persons are being treated, including their families and relatives, and imposing the appropriate penalties therein, herein otherwise known as the "Anti-COVID 19 Discrimination Ordinance of 2020" as within the conferred powers of the Sangguniang Bayan to enact;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, for its information and guidance.
