PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 788-2021

REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE PROVINCIAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE AND THE PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE TO CONSIDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL SUPPORT TO THE MEDICAL FRONTLINERS INFECTED WITH COVID-19 WHO ARE ON SELF-QUARANTINE

WHEREAS, medical frontliners have long been battling the coronavirus pandemic and they have no choice but to face the real danger in caring for their patients;

WHEREAS, some of medical frontliners who contracted mild or moderate COVID-19 symptoms preferred to self-quarantine so as not to add additional burdens to their colleagues;

WHEREAS, aside from the financial benefits they already receive from the government, medical frontliners need to be provided with support especially when they have to self-quarantine in their own homes;

WHEREAS, since it is necessary for the medical frontliners to stay at home for a number of days and they cannot absolutely go out, they need to be supported with regular medicines and meals;

WHEREAS, providing them with medicines and meals is a simple but good deed that the Province could do to ease their pain during their time of affliction;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan is requesting the Provincial Inter-Agency Task Force and the Provincial Health Office to finds ways to help the medical frontliners infected with COVID-19 who are on self-quarantine;
