

1 WHEREAS, the residents/inhabitants of the above-enumerated  
2 barangays recently are appealing that the Domalandan Marcos East-  
3 West Bridge be renamed as Justice Juan O. Reyes, Sr. Memorial  
4 Bridge in honor of the prime movant in the fulfillment of connect-  
5 ing the eight isolated barangays to the mainland of Lingayen;

6 WHEREAS, considering that the said Bridge had been built and  
7 and named as such fourteen years ago, and now could be renamed, find-  
8 ing the said move to be in order, meritorious and without any legal  
9 encumbrance;

10 WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, on motion of SP Member  
11 Romualdo G. de Leon, co-authored by all the Sangguniang Panlalawi-  
12 gan Members, duly seconded by SP Members Roberto N. Ferrer, Roberto  
13 Q. Sison, Dionisio C. Antiniw, and Leonardo S. Caranto, it was -

14 RESOLVED, by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled  
15 to rename, as it is hereby renamed, the Marcos East-West Bridge lo-  
16 cated at Domalandan, Lingayen, Pangasinan to Justice Juan O. Reyes,  
17 Sr. Memorial Bridge;

18 RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished  
19 DPWH Secretary Fiorello Estuar at his Office in Manila; Governor  
20 Rafael M. Colet at Urduja House, Lingayen; Mayor Evangelista of  
21 Lingayen; the Barangay Captains of Barangays Domalandan East, Doma-  
22 landan Center, Domalandan West, Capandanan, Malimpuc, Estanza, and  
23 Sabangan, all of Lingayen, and retired Justice Juan O. Reyes, Sr.,  
24 Domalandan Center, all for their information and referende.

25 2. Ordinance Creating the Position of  
26 One (1) Senior Legislative Staff  
27 Officer at the Office of the Secre-  
28 tariat, Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

29 The above-entitled proposed Provincial Ordinance was presented  
30 by the Majority Floor Leader, SP Member Baraan, for the consider-  
31 ation and approval of the Body.

32 There, being no objection, the said proposed ordinance, as co-  
33 authored by all the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members, including the  
34 Temporary Presiding Officer, SP Member Demetria, was spontaneously  
35 approved, as follows:

37 CREATING THE POSITION OF ONE (1) SENIOR LEGISLATIVE  
38 STAFF OFFICER AT THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARIAT,  
39 SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN

40 Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session assembled  
41 that:

42 SECTION 1 - (a) The position of one (1) Senior Legislative Staff  
43 Officer at the Office of the Secretariat, Sangguniang  
44 Panlalawigan is hereby created;

1 (b) The aforesaid creation stated in Section 1, par.  
2 (a) automatically abolished the position of one (1)  
3 Stenographic Reporter III in the same Office;

4 SECTION 2 - Effective upon approval of the Joint Commission, corres-  
5 ponding salaries for the above-mentioned item in Section  
6 1, par. (a) will be appropriated and included in the  
7 annual plantilla;

8 SECTION 3 - The initial salary of the Senior Legislative Staff Offi-  
9 cer is P63,026.40 per annum;

10 SECTION 4 - The Senior Legislative Staff Officer is urgently needed  
11 to provide the Sangguniang Panlalawigan technical support;  
12 to assist the Board Secretary IV in some of his functions  
13 and duties; and, particularly, to take charge of the pro-  
14 per management, research and handling of legislative  
15 transactions of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

16 SECTION 5 - Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon  
17 approval.

18 3. Resolution Recommending the Incorporation  
19 in the Proposed Local Government Code the  
20 Power to Barangay Captain to Appoint Barangay  
21 Councilman to fill up Vacancy in the Barangay  
22 Council, with the concurrence of the Majority  
23 Members of the Barangay Council.

24 The above-entitled proposed resolution was presented by SP Member  
25 Caranto.

26 There being no objection and further discussion, the same was  
27 approved as follows:

29 RECOMMENDING THE INCORPORATION IN THE PRO-  
30 POSED LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE THE POWER TO  
31 BARANGAY CAPTAIN TO APPOINT BARANGAY COUN-  
32 CILMAN TO FILL UP VACANCY IN THE BARANGAY  
33 COUNCIL, WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAJOR-  
34 ITY MEMBERS OF THE BARANGAY COUNCIL

35 WHEREAS, members of the Barangay Council were elected under the  
36 non-partisan doctrine as candidate, indicated in their Certificate  
37 of Candidacy- no political party affiliation;

38 WHEREAS, the doctrine of non-partisan composition of membership  
39 in the Barangay Council is a practice acceptable to the barangay  
40 constituents and so, to preserve this doctrine, in case of vacancy  
41 for the position of Barangay Councilman- the power to appoint council-  
42 man to fill up the vacancy, should be done by a non-partisan Office-  
43 the Office of the Barangay Captain, with the concurrence of the majo-  
44 rity majority of the Barangay Council Members;
