PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 91-2000

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE GOV. TEOFILO SISON BRIDGE (LAOAC BRIDGE) ALONG MANAOAG-BINALONAN ROAD

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21(a) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park, or square falling within its jurisdiction: Provided, however, That in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided;

WHEREAS, Mr. Medel D. Cunan, Project Manager of R.D. Policarpio and Co. Inc., in his letter to the Hon. Governor Victor E. Agbayani, dated March 01, 2000, sought permission for the temporary closure of the Gov. Teofilo Sison Bridge (Laoac Bridge) along Manaoag-Binalonan Road for the seismic retrofitting program of the said bridge under the Sixth Road Project ADB Road thru the DPWH;

WHEREAS, the said request was indorsed by Provincial Engineer Filipino O. Soriano as meritorious and justifiable in order to facilitate the completion of the project;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Administrator, Atty. Virgilio Q. Solis, Jr., likewise indorsed the same to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for its appropriate action on the matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member John Agerico B. Rosario, duly seconded –

Be it enacted in session assembled that:

- SECTION 1. The temporary closure of the Gov. Teofilo Sison Bridge (Laoac Bridge) along Manaoag-Binalonan Road is hereby authorized subject to the following conditions:
 - a) That a detour route/s must be clearly identified for the comfort and convenience of the motorists and the riding public;
 - b) That subject closure shall be effective based strictly on the conditions and specifications stipulated in the contract; and
 - c) That the provincial government for its guidance and appropriate action, must be informed upon nearing the completion of the said project.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
